Driver Coronavirus Policy

v1 5-29-20

You're some of the best drivers out there, professional, courteous, and experienced; that's why you're on the SLO Safe Ride team. We know that you'll work hard to ensure the well-being of your riders in addition to yourself. We've implemented several procedures to help keep you and your passengers safe and informed during this time. If you have any questions, please contact the leadership team and they'll be happy to review the below procedure with you again.

- 1) Wear a cloth face covering for all driving shifts. Please make sure that you have a covering that will stay securely over your mouth and nose.
- 2) Have someone take your temperature prior to all shifts with one of our contactless thermometers.
- 3) Before passengers board the bus, take their temperature using a contactless thermometer.
 - a. If anyone refuses a test or tests over 99 degrees, speak to the group leader about what they would like to do. Ideally, they will not join on the trip, however, we cannot force anyone to do anything.
- 4) Limit close contact with passengers (less than six feet) when possible.
- 5) Use a Clorox/Lysol disinfectant wipe to clean surfaces in the driver compartment that are commonly touched.
- 6) As part of your safety speech, read the Coronavirus statement that we will provide to you. The group leader will sign a sheet each trip that will include a note "I have heard the Coronavirus statement."
- 7) Use hand sanitizer before and after each trip.
- 8) Use hand sanitizer after touching any items that the customers have touched.
- 9) If you are ill, do not come to work. Communicate with Ryan Kennedy so that he can get your shift covered. If you cannot reach him, contact Julian Harris, Noah Raynor, or Trevor Freeman. If you have been in contact with someone that has tested positive for Coronavirus, communicate that with management as well.
- 10) Avoid using the recirculated air option in the bus ventilation system.
